PIEI-ROMANIA

In Romania, July is considered the month of fire because of its rising temperature in the summer. Even though it's very hot outside, the heat won't stop us from bringing the fire of the Lord to people's hearts!

As you know, the fire of the Lord comes when we preach the Gospel to his people. We are able to do this through a camp that Brandon and I organized. My job for that camp was to preach the Word of God. The main topic we focused on was knowing Jesus as the Living Water, a Light of the World, and as a Good Shepherd.



I was filled with joy when I saw people interacting in small groups and when the youth stepped up to share their faith through their testimonies. Some of them even said, "Now I know Jesus as my Shepherd." I thank you to those

who interceded in prayer for us as well as those who supported financially, as many of the youth are not able to pay for themselves.

Another major blessing was coordinating the Parent Vision Trip (PVT) with Fusion Squad, through which we were able to accomplish another goal from the New Testament Project. We selected a neighborhood in Craiova to distribute a Bible to every single house. Around 900 families were able to receive the New Testament. As you already know, this is a huge accomplishment for us because, although we are not able to plant a church in every single town, we are at least able to bring the Gospel to every single house.

Romans 10:14-15 says, "How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching? And how are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is written, 'How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!'"

In addition to PVT, for the first time in our ministry we had a church from Switzerland join us.

They sent a team here for a Vision Trip, but they weren't just coming to see the ministry. They were active in passing out the Bibles, distributing food, construction projects, and more! Overall, over 150 kids were blessed by their presence.

Even July was a fire month, as there was a lot of heat, but, by the grace of God, we were able to put a good fire on the altar for God's glory.

Romans 12:13, Hebrews 13:2 This month was a month of hospitality. The whole month we hosted a christian student who did not have a place to stay to for school. We blessed her, but she also blessed us in the ministry and in our family. We planned two days of surveying on campus with a team of American students. The purpose was to make new relationships and to plan a volleyball event. We had the opportunity to meet a lot of students on campus and in the park, but only one student came to the volleyball night and he was a Muslim. I did not get discouraged see only one person because I remember that my role is only to put in their hearts and their minds the truth. My desire is to make disciples but I know that God is the one who is planting and growing that seed.


Also we praise the Lord for the family that donated for some work on the house so the new pastor Sami and his wife Loredana can move in, in October.
