I want to share two cases with your as prayer request. It is about the possibility of recruiting two servants, Helen and Saige. After few conversations with them I realized that Helen was burdened in her heart for the children in our area. She wants to tell and show them God's love. Saige was moved by the old people and her heart's desire is to help them. In both cases I used the example of Nehemiah who heard about a vulnerable Jerusalem, without walls and with a lost reputation. This burden caused him to act later. So the burdened Nehemiah (chapter 1:1-4) made the difference for Israelites (chapter 6:15-16). God's Spirit used His Word to bring light and clarity for those two girls. Both of them are right know in

the process of seeking God's will for their lives. In the second case is about a young man who was about to commit suicide (from his stories). We had long discussions, we prayed and I encouraged him to see his

life from an eternal perspective. I helped him to overcome this critical time in his life and to open his heart to God. Pray for me to continue this rehabilitation process to his conversion.

Even if it was one exhausting month, intense, sometimes with conflicts and problems, hard mediation cases, however in my soul I am honored to celebrate my King, Jesus!
