There could not have been a more pleasant beginning for May; in which we celebrated the resurrection of Christ. Thank God, who is working and orchestrating things beautifully in His time, in which we walk and work to for His glory. In May we organized two special events. The first is the "Bible Overview" during which ministers of the RESO ministry were equipped. The second event, was a traveling event in European countries, where we visited the churches that already are in partnership or willing to support our mission work.

Professor Tayo, from GEM (Grace Evangelistic Ministries) is the one who taught the course in England. I organized the logistics for the conference. This course is the first of a curriculum which will last 5 years.

Personally, I learned in this course that we can see evangelizing as a story of God's love: starting from creation, His desire to relate to his creation, the fall of man into sin, His judgment and fulfillment of the promise of God through the Lord Jesus, restoration of relationship with His creation fallen.

As a ministry we try every 3-5 years to visit our partners in the Diaspora.



This year's visit was aimed at strengthening existing relationships, recruiting new partners and potential new workers in these churches. An experience this journey that was encouraging to see was that Divine logistics surprised and strengthened us as we walk in His timing.

On the first Sunday morning service in Austria, I went to a new church. I arrived one hour before service. At the same time came the worship band rehearsal. I immediately recognized two of them. People who after almost five years, while they were in Italy, visited Oltenia and served with us.

They are hungry for the Word of God. We met for 2 hours every week. Please pray for these girls that they would receive Christ and be examples in their school, as well in the town.

During the years we have wanted to share the gospel in different ways so we have shared christian literature, evangelized on streets, invited people to evangelistic events, done children programs, distributed new testaments, and did bible studies.
